


Ellen Heywood

This is my pattern, for my dog Jaz, front and back. 2021






Meredith Sewell

This is a small quilt, 49" x 49", made from a kit purchased some time ago. The pattern is *Baby Charms* by *Straight to the Point*. The kit included a charm pack and coordinating fabrics for borders. The 4 patch blocks were pieced and sewn and then the quilt was cut diagonally and repositioned. Sara Parker Yoder quilted it for me.
