THERE ARE THREE FABRICS INCLUDED FOR THE "A", "B", AND "C" PIECES,

AND EACH PACKET HAS A DIFFERENT THREE FABRICS. ALL FABRICS HAVE

BEEN WASHED. TEMPLATES FOR THE "A", "B", AND "C" PIECES ARE

INCLUDED. THEY DO NOT INCLUDE SEAM ALLOWANCE. USE YOUR

FABRICS IN ANY COMBINATION WHICH PLEASES YOU -- WE WOULD LIKE

A 600D VARIETY OF COLOR PLACEMENT. "D" PIECES MARKED ON SEWING LINE

STEP 1: CUT OUT 16"A", 4 "B", 1 "C", AND 4 "D". MAKE SURE

YOU ADD SEAM ALLOWANCE.

STEP 2: SEW 4 "A" PIECES TOGETHER TO MAKE ONE POINT; REPEAT

FOR 3 MORE POINTS. "A" UNIT

STEP 3: SEW A 'B' PIECE TO EACH SIDE OF THE "C" PIECE.

"BC"

STEP 4: USING TWO "A" POINT UNITS, SEW THEM TO OPPOSITE SIDES OF THE "BC" SQUARE, "ABCA" UNIT

STEP 5: SEW A "D" PIECE TO EACH SIDE OF THE TWO REMAINING "A" POINT UNITS.

STEP 6: SEW A "DAD" UNIT TO EACH SIDE OF YOUR "ABOA" UNIT.
PLEASE RETURN ALL EXTRA FABRIC.
